## On the Road Again

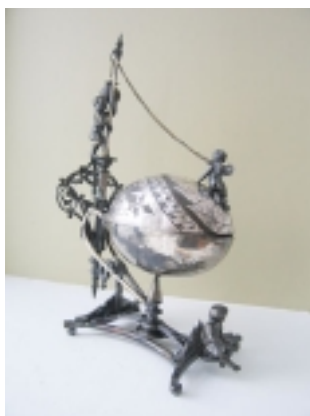

## Interesting Windows



These two stained glass windows can be found at **Traveller Antiques** in Edmonton. They have quite an interesting history.

These windows came from The Royal Alexandra Hotel (a CP hotel) in Winnipeg that was built in 1906. It was actually a combination hotel and railway station, designed by the Maxwell brothers of Montreal (architects), noted for integrating the work of colleague artists into their buildings **including stained glass** [from Castle & Son or from Bromsgrove Guild of England]. The hotel was demolished in 1971 and the materials were sold at auction [Allan Stern of Winnipeg, responsible for the auctioning, also knew and loved the hotel].
