Dionne Quintuplet Memorabilia



Did you know there is a diehard group of enthusiasts who collect Dionne Quintuplet memorabilia? Well, there is and the headquarters for this club is now based in Canada.

The Dionne Quint Collectors Too Club was organized in August 2007, following the untimely passing of the co-founders of the Dionne Quintuplet Collectors Club, founded in 1979 by Woburn, MA residents Jimmy and Fay Rodolfos. As its predecessor, the purpose of the Dionne Quint Collectors Too Club is to share information, knowledge and friendship through Quintuplet collecting.

Jimmy and Fay, documented in Ellie Teshler's 1998 book, *The Dionnes*,

produced quarterly newsletters for a membership exceeding 300 members around the world, in addition to hosting a Quinvention held every five years in Boston. With the untimely passing of Jimmy and Fay earlier this year, long time collector and DQC member Leonard Belsher of Shawville, Quebec, rose to the challenge of nurturing the interest held by 'Quinters' worldwide.

Leonard was already busy organizing the next Quinvention, which will be held in Canada for the first time ever in 2009. The North Bay area, which was put on the world map with the birth of the first quintuplets ever to survive beyond infancy – will host the Quinters as they congregate in the environs of 'Quintland,' where it all began back in 1934. Coincidentally, May 28, 2009 will mark the 75th anniversary of the birth of the famous five: Annette, Cecile, Emilie, Marie and Yvonne. 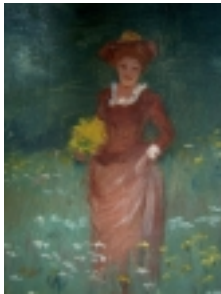

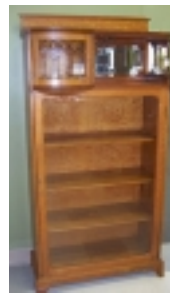
