The Carousel opened its doors November 1994 by a group of Summerland ladies. The idea came from one of the ladies who imported craft items from Ecuador. She invited local potters, basket weavers, a clothing designer and an antique collector to join with her. It proved successful so a larger store was rented. The membership has changed over the years and now we are selling mostly antiques and

collectibles with a total of nine members.

We have a variety of items including Moorcroft and Roseville, sterling silver, small furniture, pictures including original art and prints, books, glassware and collectibles.

In 2005 we placed first for best antique store in the South Okanagan by Okanagan Life magazine. Of this we are proud.
